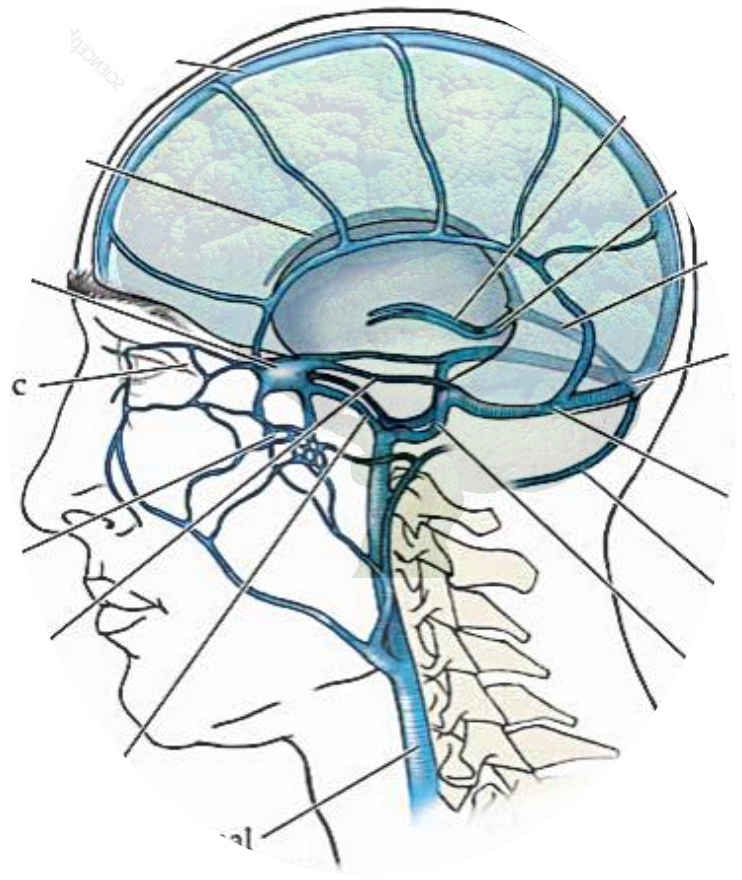
Blood Vessels and Circulation



Cerebral Arteries

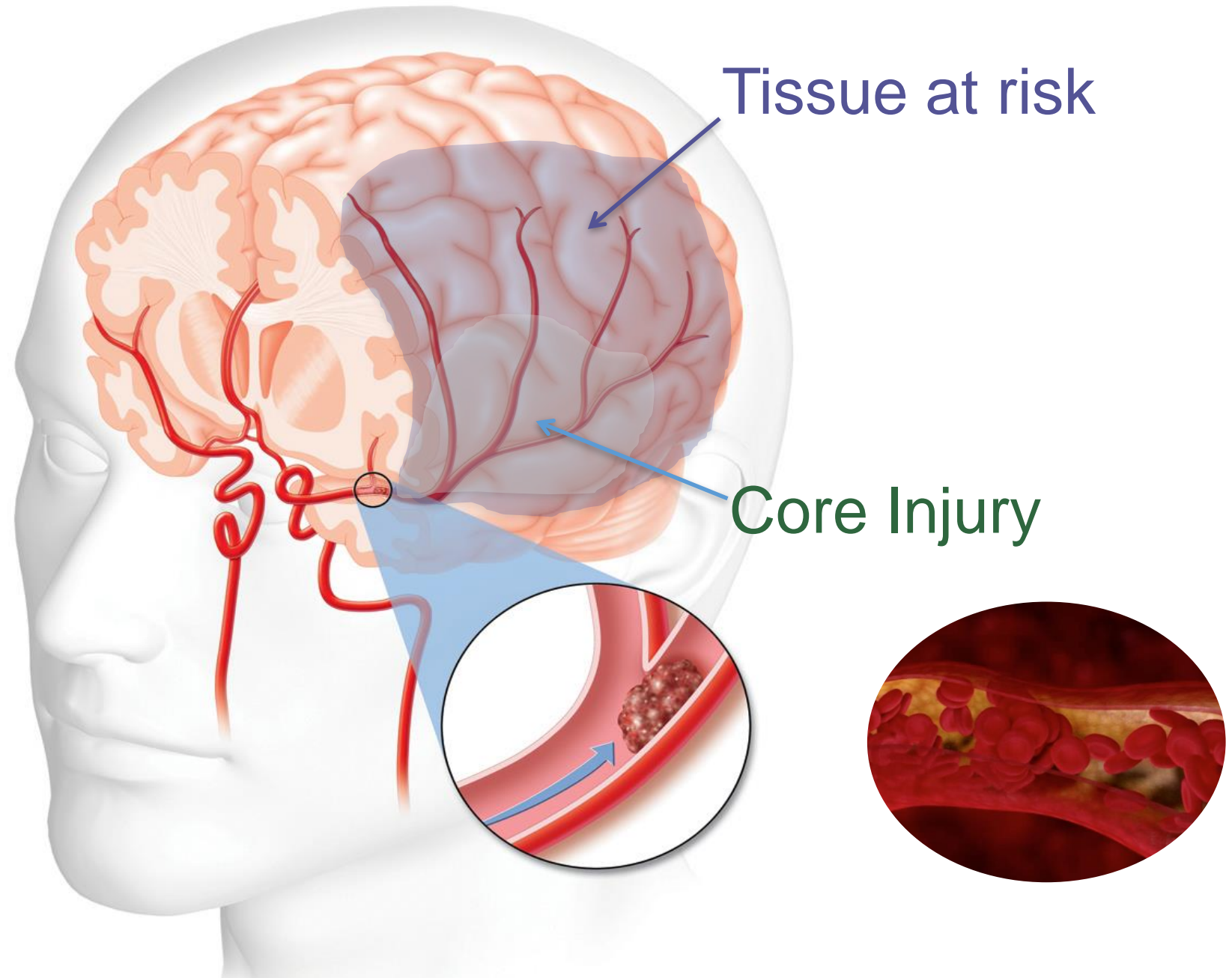


Cerebral Veins (Dural Sinuses)



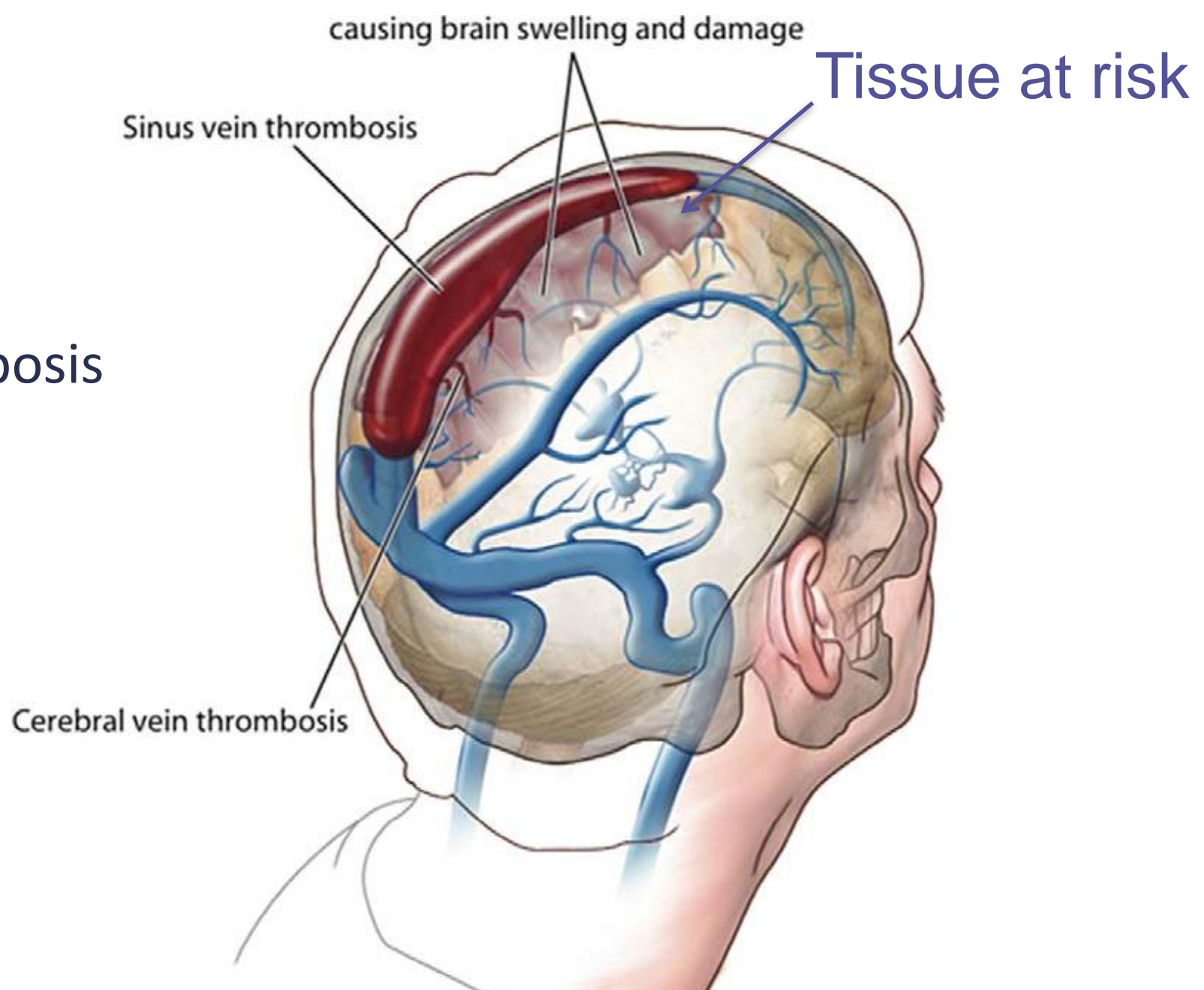
Types of Stroke:

- Arterial Ischemic



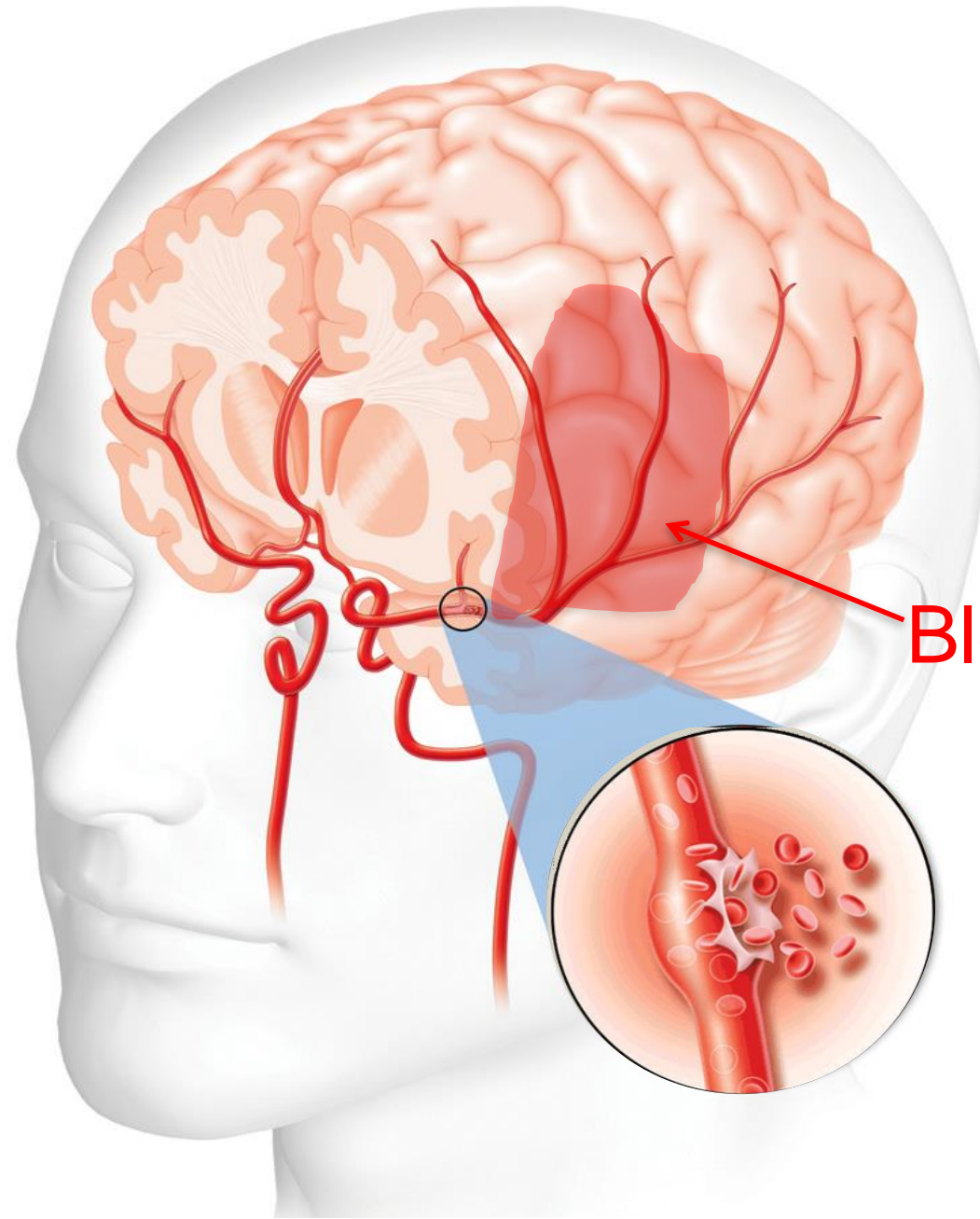
Types of Stroke:
